Roll Up the Rim Toque

Easy peasy! This pattern is my *toque* favourite! Use it for a child, a lady or a man, depending on the size of needles and the style, colour and thickness of yarn. I like using round needles, as you see in the diagram below. Don't forget to use a row counter to help you with the rounds.

This pattern can be for a lady if you use a chunky yarn and 6 mm double pointed needles.

Hat worked in the round.

Cast on 63 (66) sts

Knit in the round until 21 (22) cm in stocking stitch (st.st)

Shape Top:

K1, K2 tog until end of round K – 3 rounds

K2 tog until end of round

K – 2 rounds

K2 tog until 6 st remain

Break yarn and draw up.

Don't be lazy, weave in loose ends.









This pattern is also a wonderful way to use up scraps of yarn to make the most beautiful toques.
